What should you expect from providers in non English countries?

- **Affordable treatment**
- **Lower waiting time for surrogates and egg donors**
- **Friendly staff**
- **High quality care**
- **State of art laboratories**
- **Well established regulations**

Timelines You Should Expect

- **Contact with agency/clinic**

- **First visit Paperwork/Medical check (2-3 days)**

- **Egg donor selection/IVF (2 months)**

- **Genetic screening of embryos (2-3 weeks)**

- **Surrogate selection/embryo transfer (2 months)**

- **Pregnancy monitoring**

- **Infant Birth (9 months)**



Egg Donor Databases

- **Should provide wide selection**
- **Open donor profiles**
- **Varied nationalities**

Egg Donor Profiles Should Include

- **Physical Characteristics**
- **Family Characteristics**
- **Education**
- **Hobbies**
- **Social and Personal History**
- **Obstetric History**
- **Medical History**
- **Family Medical History**



Egg Donor Screening Should Include...

- **Age 18-30**
- **BMI**
- **General health status screening**
- **Reproductive health screening**
- **Infectious diseases screening**

- **At least one own child**
- **General health status**
- **Reproductive health**
- **Infectious diseases screening**

Steps in Surrogate preparation

- Day 9 check endometrium thickness and structure
- 
- Surrogate medical Approval
- 
- Lab test and examinations
- 
- Endometrium preparation
- 
- Hormone Monitoring (US protocol)

- Final IP confirmation
- 
- Embryo transfer
- 
- Pregnancy confirmation
- 
- Pregnancy supervision

Communication with non-English-speaking Surrogates

- Local agency/clinic should provide qualified translator
- Can meet once surrogate is approved and selected

- Via   or other channel

- Contact post birth is possible. Agreed privately between parties
